This review of the Bay Area Wetlands Ecosystem Goals Project will focus on its science support, including the development of a common technical vocabulary for wetlands form and function, the analysis of historical landscape change to understand habitat controls, the substitution of collective field experience for data, the creation and use of maps for integrating recommendations across scientific disciplines.
