SPL Recommendations – A five-year plan?

Davis et al. (2000)

- Watershed characterization: characterize and classify the watersheds in the region <u>STARTED</u>
- Establish regional network of "observation watersheds for long-term evaluation NOT DONE
- Extrapolate existing data to other watersheds as appropriate based on characteristics and processes <u>NOT</u> <u>DONE</u>

Leatherbarrow et al. 2002

- Explore and develop alternative load indicators for determining trends in contaminant loading in the tributaries NOT DONE
- Coordinate future tributary monitoring with developing and continuing watershed management efforts (e.g., BASMAA) to relate changes in contaminant concentration and loading at the lower end of the watersheds to the combined effects of potential sources in the watersheds, watershed characteristics and hydrology, and management actions NOT DONE

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
