	was observed for the years 2004 through 2006. A thorough review	
	of possible explanations was conducted and it was found that	
	improvements in the analytical technique resulted in better	
	recovery. It is possible that a similar under-reporting may have	
	occurred for PAHs, Pesticides, and PBDEs. We are requesting	
	funds to analyze three sites for these compounds to determine	
	whether similar qualifications of the data are needed.
